# BEE FRIENDLY PLANTS AUSTRALIAN NATIVES



## **BRISBANE WATTLE**

Species: Acacia fimbriata Family: Mimosaceae

**Description:** Medium size tree, up to 6m. Produces highly perfumed, yellow flowers.

Care: Full sun to part shade. Low to Moderate watering needs.

Prefers well draining sandy soils.

# **ZIG-ZAG WATTLE**

Species: Acacia macradenia Family: Mimosaceae

**Description:** Medium open shrubby tree growing to 5m. Distinctive zigzag shaped branches. Bright, golden Flowers grow in dense clusters.

**Care:** Full sun to part shade. Drought tolerant once established. Prefers well draining sandy soils.





## OLD SILVER WATTLE

Species: Acacia podalyriifolia Family: Mimosaceae

**Description:** Medium tree growing to 6m. Distinctive silver grey leaves. Produces fragrant yellow flowers.

Care: Full sun. Low watering needs, avoid water-logging. Does well in all soil types.

#### I FMON IRONWOOD

Species: Backhousia citriodora Family: Myrtaceae

**Description:** Medium sized tree to 12m. Foliage dense all the way to ground. Produces a strong lemon scent. Small white flowers.

**Care:** Full sun. Tolerates most well-drained soils, prefers rich soil with mulch. Suitable for pots, hedges and gardens.





## GOLDEN GLORY TREE

Species: Barklya syringifolia Family: Caesalpineaceae

**Description:** Medium sized tree to 15m. Leaves are heart shaped. Produces sprays of orange-yellow flowers.

**Care:** Full sun or part shade. Preferring good soil and drainage. Slow growing but flowers early.

## **IVORY CURL**

Species: Buckinghamia celsissima Family: Proteaceae

**Description:** Medium sized tree growing 10-15 meters tall.

Known for its stunning ivory-colored flowers that curl at the ends.

**Care:** Full sun. Prefers well-drained rich soil. Drought tolerant once established. Prefers warm coastal climates.









## **BULBINE LILY**

Species: Bulbine bulbosa Family: Asphodelaceae

**Description:** Clumping perennial herb reaching 75cm. Produces bright yellow star-like flowers.

Care: Part shade. Tolerates most well drained soils. Water regularly Frost tolerant.

# **GOLD-TIPPED BOTTLE BRUSH**

Species: Callistemon polandii Family: Myrtaceae

**Description:** Dense shrub growing to 4m. Produces abundant displays of red flowers in Spring.

# WEEPING BOTTLEBRUSH

Species: Callistemon viminalis Family: Myrtaceae

**Description:** Small tree growing to 10m. Produces mass amounts of vibrant red flowers

Care: Full Sun. Will take to most soil types. Drought tolerant once established

# **BROWN KUURAIONG**

Species: Commersonia bartramia Family: Sterculiaceae

**Description:** Bushy shrub/small tree grows to 6 m. Heart shaped leaves. Cream flowers in axillary heads.

Care: Full sun or part shade. Prefers well drained soil. Water every 2 to 3 weeks.





#### **RIVER LILY**

Species: Crinum pedunculatum Family: Amaryllidaceae

**Description:** Large bulbous perennial herb, which may reach 2 metres high by a 2-3 metre spread. Produces tall white flowers through Spring and Summer.

**Care:** Full sun or part shade. Prefers well drained moist soils. Water regularly.

## **BLUE FLAX LILY**

Species: Dianella caerulea Family: Hemerocallidaceae

**Description:** Grows to 1m. Flax-like leaves. Small blue flowers with prominent yellow anthers on branched spikes.. Globular blue fruits.

**Care:** Full sun to part shade. Hardy plant which is drought and frost tolerant once established.





## SPOTTED EMU BUSH

Species: Eremophila maculata Family: Scrophulariaceae

**Description:** Low spreading shrub. Grows to 2m. The flower colour varies and may be pink, mauve, red, orange or yellow,

Care: Full sun. Prefers well draining alkaline soils. Drought tolerant once established.







## **HOLLY-LEAVED FUCHSIA**

Species: Graptophyllum ilicifolium Family: Acanthaceae

**Description:** Medium shrub growing 3-5m. Bright scarlet-purple flowers occur in spring and early summer.

**Care:** Part shade. Prefers moist well draining soils Water regularly until established.

## RED-FLOWERED SILKY OAK

Species: Grevillea banksii Family: Proteaceae

**Description:** Small tree growing to 5m. Attractive red or cream flowers in spikes to 18cm. Produces woody seed capsules with 1- 2 seeds.

Care: Full sun. Very hardy and drought tolerant once established.

Prefers well draining soils. Prefers warmer climates.





# **FALSE SARSAPARILLA**

Species: Hardenbergia violacea Family: Fabaceae

**Description:** Small climbing vine to about 1m2. Eye catching flowers in various shades of purple.

Care: Full sun to part shade. Prefer moist, well drained sandy soil.

# WHITE EVERLASTING

Species: Helichrysum elatum Family: Asteraceae

**Description:** Erect perennial to 2 m. Stems and leaves clothed with white woolly hairs. Produces clusters of papery white flower heads.

Care: Full sun. Fast growing and low maintenance, tolerant of poor soil conditions and drought.





## **SNAKE VINE**

Species: Hibbertia scandens Family: Dilleniaceae

**Description:** A robust climbing plant. Produces large yellow flowers during late spring and summer. Excellent ground cover plant.

**Care:** Full sun or part shade. Flowers best in full sun. Prefers well drained soil. Drought tolerant once established.

## **NATIVE ROSELLA**

Species: Hibiscus heterophyllus Family: Malvaceae

**Description:** Small tree/shrub 3-6m. Produces an abundance of large flowers in a variety of colours.

**Care:** Full sun to part shade. Tolerates a range of soil types and climates but prefers warm moist environments.





## **PINK HIBISCUS**

Species: Hibiscus splendens Family: Malvaceae

**Description:** Medium to large shrub growing 3-6m. The leaves are hairy and quite large. Flowers are large an of typical hibiscus shape.

**Care:** Full sun to part shade. Prefers well-drained soils. Drought and frost tolerant.







## **PURPLE BUSH PEA**

Species: Hovea longifolia Family: Fabaceae

**Description:** Small shrub growing to 2m. Narrow leaves and mauve-blue pea-flowers.

Care: Part shade. Adapts to most soil types. Hardy plant that is frost tolerant. Moderate water needs.

# **TEA TREE**

Species: Leptospermum sp Family: Myrtaceae

**Description:** Small to medium trees. White is the predominant flower colour, but there are a few species which produce pink or red flowers.

**Care:** Full sun to part shade. Prefers well draining acidic soils. Requires moderate amounts of water.





# WHITE KAMALA

Species: Mallotus discolor Family: Euphorbiaceae

**Description:** Medium tree growing to 10 m. Leaves are green on top and silvery on underside. Insignificant flowers but produces large amounts of fruit.

Care: Full sun. Water every 2-3 weeks, drought tolerant once established. Does well in all soil types.

# FLAX LEAVED PAPERBARK

Species: Melaleuca trichostachya Family: Myrtaceae

**Description:** Medium sized bushy tree to 8m with paper bark. White flowers in cylindrical spikes to 3cm.

Care: Full sun or part Shade. Prefers moist, sandy soils.





# **BLACK TEA TREE**

Species: Melaleuca bracteata Family: Myrtaceae

 $\textbf{Description:} \ \ \text{Medium sized bushy tree growing to 8m. White or cream flowers in leafy cylindrical spikes to 5 cm.}$ 

Care: Full sun. Preferring well drained soil. Very hardy plant but does require watering every 1-2 weeks.

## WEEPING PAPER BARK

Species: Melaleuca leucadendra Family: Myrtaceae

**Description:** Large tree to 20m. The flowers are cream, white or greenish-white.

Care: Full sun. Drought tolerant once established.





#### HONEY MYRTLE

Species: Melaleuca thymifolia Family: Myrtaceae

**Description:** Fine-leaved bushy native shrub Growing to 1m Produces purple-pink feathery flowers in summer-autumn.

**Care:** Full sun to part shade. Prefers well draining soils. Drought and frost tolerant once established.







## **BROAD-LEAVED TEA TREE**

Species: Melaleuca viridiflora Family: Myrtaceae

**Description:** Medium sized paperbark to 10 m. Flowers in cylindrical spikes to 10 cm, white, green, pink or red.

Care: Full sun to part shade. Tolerates a variety of soil types including waterlogged areas. Requires little watering once established.

## NATIVE MURRAYA

Species: Murraya ovatifoliolata Family: Rutaceae

**Description:** Small shrubby tree to 4 m. Produces fragrant white flowers and red fleshy fruits.

Care: Full sun to part shade. Prefers warm, humid climates and welldrained soils. Sensitive to frost





## **BOWER VINE**

Species: Pandorea jasminoides Family: Bignoniaceae

**Description:** Vigorous climbing twiner. Produces large pink trumpetshaped flowers with maroon centres. Suitable for trellis or ground cover.

**Care:** Full sun or light shade. Requires a moist, fertile, well-draining soil. Water regularly.

# **WONGA WONGA VINE**

Species: Pandorea pandorana Family: Bignoniaceae

**Description:** Vigorous climbing twiner. Tubular flowers come in a variety of colours from white and maroon to white and gold or brown.

**Care:** Full sun. Water regularly allowing the soil to dry out between waterings. Sensitive to frost.





## **LOVE FLOWER**

Species: Pseuderanthemum variabile Family: Acanthaceae

**Description:** Perennial plant to 30 cm but usually less. Spikes of pink to lilac tubular flowers with spreading lobes.

**Care:** Shade with bright indirect light. Prefers warm humid environments. Water regularly.



Species: Psydrax odorata Family: Rubiaceae

**Description:** Small to medium sized tree growing to 6 m. Attractive foliage. Produces fragrant white flowers in clusters and black fruit.

**Care:** Full sun. Prefers well-drained soil. Drought tolerant once established. Sensitive to frost.





#### PAPER DAISY

Species: Rhodanthe sp Family: Asteraceae

**Description:** Small clumping plant which grows flowers on tall stems to 30 cm high. A number of species come in a variety of colours.

**Care:** Full sun. Low to Tolerant to most soil types but prefers more fertile soils. Water regularly.







## **GLOSSY SHOWER**

Species: Senna surattensis Family: Caesalpiniaceae

**Description:** Small tree/shrub which uses other plants for support. Grows to 5 m. Produces attractive sprays of yellow flowers.

Care: Full sun. Prefers well draining loamy soils. Water regularly allowing soil to dry out between watering. Sensitive to frost.

## **NECKLACE BEAN**

Species: Sophora tomentosa Family: Fabaceae

**Description:** Small shrubby tree Grey-green foliage. Clusters of pods necked in between seeds to give necklace effect.

Care: Full sun to part shade. Will grow even in poor soil. Tolerant of drought, salt spray and wind once established. Great for coastal regions





# **SMOOTH DARLING PEA**

Species: Swainsona galegifolia Family: Fabaceae

**Description:** Perennial growing to 1 m. Produces sprays of large pea flowers which vary from white to deep red, though most commonly mauve-pink.

Care: Full sun. Adaptable to a variety of well-drained soils. Sensitive to frost.

# BLUE LILLY PILLY

Species: Syzygium oleosum Family: Myrtaceae

**Description:** Small tree growing to 8m. Very aromatic. Produces showy white flowers. Fruit are blue when ripe.

Care: Part shade. Prefers rich, moist, well-drained soils. Water regularly until established.





# RIBERRY LILLY PILLY

Species: Syzygium luehmannii Family: Myrtaceae

**Description:** Medium to large tree growing to 20 m. Young growth red or bright pink. Produces white fluffy flowers and red pear-shaped fruit.

**Care:** Full sun or part shade. Grows in a variety of soil types. Water regularly until established. Sensitive to frost.

## WHITE BUTTERCUP

Species: Turnera Subulata Family: Passifloraceae

**Description:** Perennial herb growing to around 80 cm. Flowers are rounded and 3cm. Toxic to humans, dogs an cats.

Care: Full sun. Prefers well-drained rich soil. Water and fertilise







#### COASTAL ROSEMARY

Species: Westringia fruticosa Family: Lamiaceae

**Description:** Bush growing to around 2m. Dense, fine leaves and small white flowers.

Care: Full sun or part shade. Requires well draining soil. Water weekly.
